- iv) All players must wear the correct club uniform at matches – Blue Mazenod Hockey Socks; Blue Mazenod Sport shorts; and Club singlet. If wearing a cap, it must be soft peaked and blue.
- v) Players and parents are expected to represent the club in a positive manner consistent with our values as a family based club. Players, Coaches, Administrators and Parents agree to abide by the Club's Codes of Conduct which are available in either hard or soft copy.
- vi) **PAYMENT OF FEES:** All fees must be paid by **19th March 2017** (unless a prior payment arrangement has been made)
- vii) I am aware that playing Hockey, observing Hockey, learning to play Hockey and training to play Hockey, and participating in any activity carried out by the Club, are activities that inherently involve risk, and that in undertaking the activities my child does so at his/her own risk. I am also aware that, as a condition of my child's admission to membership of the Club, its office bearers, officials, coaches, managers, umpires, members, and/or agents are absolved from all liability arising from injury or damage howsoever caused.
